GRANNY HEART CROCHET TUTORIAL

A beautiful heart made with classic granny stitch



MATERIALS

- Worsted Weight Cotton Yarn (3 colors)
 - Color A: Dark Blue
 - Color B: Light Blue
 - Color C: Cream
- 4.0 mm (G/6) Crochet Hook
- Yarn Needle
- Scissors

SIZE

Approx. 6.5 inches (16.5 cm) wide and 5.5 inches (14 cm) tall.

STITCH LEGEND (US TERMS)

- ch Chain
- sl st Slip Stitch
- dc Double Crochet
- tr Treble (Triple) Crochet
- dc2tog Double Crochet 2 Together
- () Repeat instructions

SPECIAL STITCHES

dc2tog (Double Crochet 2 Together):

Yarn over, insert hook in stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over, pull through 2 loops. Yarn over again, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop (4 loops on hook), yarn over, pull through all 4 loops.

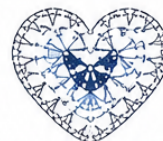
PATTERN OVERVIEW

The heart is worked from the center outwards in rounds using the granny stitch pattern. You will change colors as indicated.

- Color A (Dark Blue)
- Color B (Light Blue)
- Color C (Cream)



Start at the center (Color A)



Work in rounds, changing colors



Heart shape is formed

STEP-BY-STEP PATTERN

RING

Make a magic ring.

ROUND 1 (Color A)

Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in ring. Ch 2. 3 dc in ring. Ch 2. 3 dc in ring. Ch 2. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. (12 dc, 4 ch-2 spaces)

ROUND 2 (Color B)

Sl st into ch-2 space. Ch 3. 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in same space. *3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 space. Repeat * to * around. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. (24 dc)

ROUND 3 (Color C)

Sl st into ch-2 space. Ch 3. 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in same space. *3 dc in next ch-2 space. 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 space. Repeat * to * around, ending with 3 dc in last ch-2 space. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.

ROUND 4 (Color B)

Sl st into ch-2 space. Ch 3. 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in same space. *3 dc in each of next 2 ch-2 spaces. 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 space. Repeat * to * around, ending with 3 dc in each of last 2 ch-2 spaces. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.

ROUND 5 (Color A)

Sl st into ch-2 space. Ch 3. 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in same space. *3 dc in each of next 3 ch-2 spaces. 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 space. Repeat * to * around, ending with 3 dc in each of last 3 ch-2 spaces. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.

BORDER (Color B)

Ch 1. Work sc evenly around the heart, placing (2 sc, ch 2, 2 sc) in the top center (indent) and (1 sc, ch 1, 1 sc) at the bottom point. Join with sl st. Fasten off and weave in ends.

HEART CROCHET CHART (STEP-BY-STEP)

STEP 1: RING (Color A)

STEP 3: ROUND 2 (Color B)



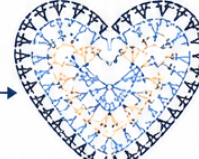
STEP 4: ROUND 3 (Color C)

STEP 6: ROUND 5 (Color A)



- Color A (Dark Blue)
- Color B (Light Blue)
- Color C (Cream)
- ch (chain)
- sl st (slip stitch)
- dc (double crochet)
- tr (treble crochet)
- dc2tog (double crochet 2 together)

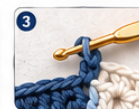
HOW TO CHANGE COLORS



Work the last stitch of the round with the new color.



Yarn over with the new color and pull through.



Continue with the new color for the next round.



Weave in the ends neatly.

FINISHING

- Block the heart gently to shape it.
- Weave in all ends with a yarn needle.
- Use it as an applique, coaster, ornament, or gift!

Enjoy your beautiful

TIPS

- Use a magic ring for a tight center.
- Keep your tension even for a smooth shape.
- You can make the heart bigger by adding more rounds.

ABBREVIATIONS (US)

ch: chain
sl st: slip stitch
dc: double crochet
tr: treble (triple) crochet
sc: single crochet

This **Granny Heart Crochet Pattern** is worked from the center outward in **5 rounds** using standard **US crochet terms**. The pattern creates a beautiful heart-shaped motif that can be used for blankets, pillows, wall décor, bags, baby items, or joined into larger projects. Follow each round carefully and change colors according to the chart if desired.

🧶 Step 1 – Materials & Stitch Guide

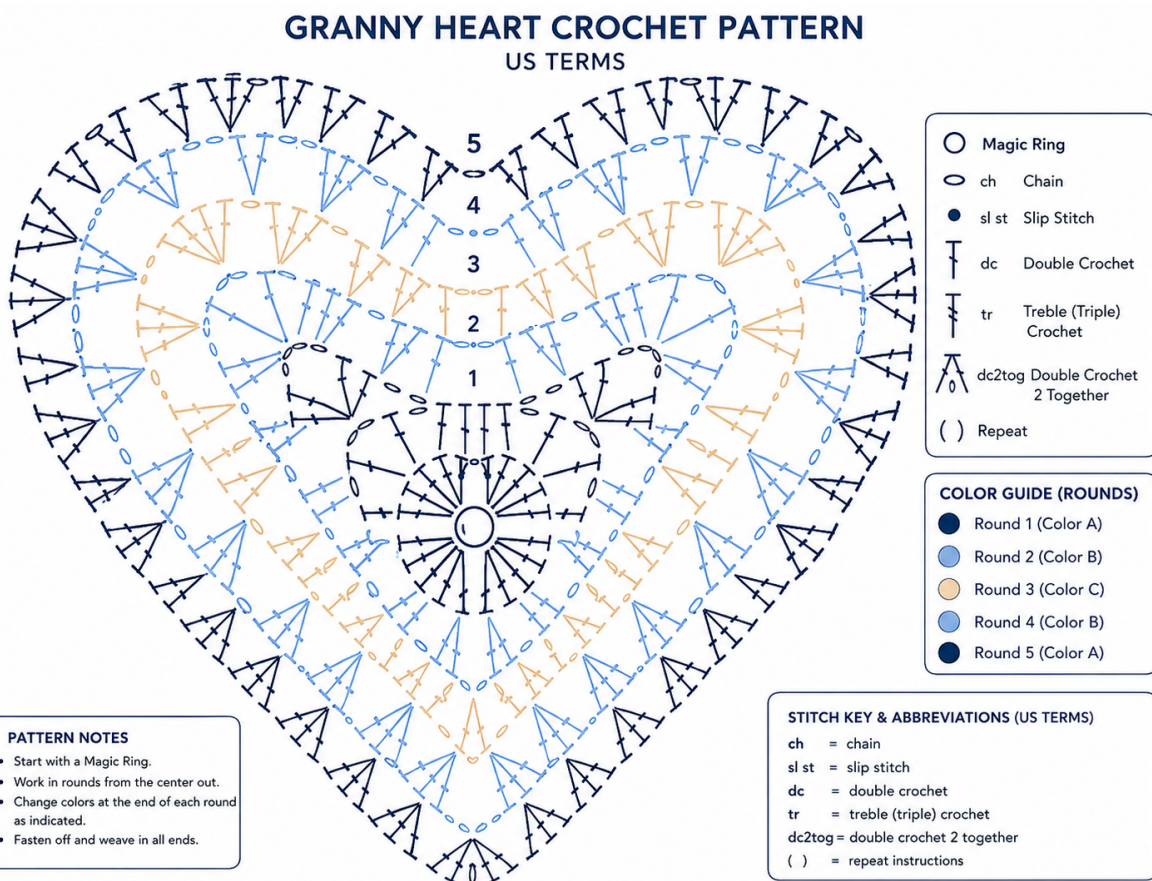
Before you begin, gather the following materials:

- Worsted Weight Yarn (Color A, Color B, Color C)
- 5.0 mm (H/8) Crochet Hook
- Yarn Needle
- Scissors
- Stitch Marker (Optional)

US Crochet Abbreviations

- **MR** – Magic Ring
- **ch** – Chain
- **sl st** – Slip Stitch
- **dc** – Double Crochet
- **tr** – Treble (Triple) Crochet
- **dc2tog** – Double Crochet 2 Together
- **()** – Repeat instructions inside parentheses

Always read the entire round before starting.



❤️ Step 2 – Round 1 (Color A)

Begin with a **Magic Ring**.

Work the following stitches into the ring:

- Ch 3 (counts as first dc)
- 15 dc into the Magic Ring
- Pull the ring tightly closed.
- Join with a **sl st** to the top of the beginning chain.

You should now have a small circle with evenly spaced stitches.

Fasten off if changing colors.

💙 Step 3 – Round 2 (Color B)

Join Color B in any stitch.

Work groups of stitches exactly as shown in the chart.

The round begins forming the top curves of the heart.

Repeat around:

- Ch 2
- 2 dc in designated spaces
- Ch spaces separate each stitch group.
- Work additional dc groups where indicated.
- Join with a slip stitch.

Keep your tension even so the heart stays flat.

💛 Step 4 – Round 3 (Color C)

Attach Color C.

This round creates the heart's rounded shape.

Follow the diagram carefully:

- Work clusters of dc into each chain space.
- Use chain stitches between clusters.
- Increase where the chart widens.
- Mirror both sides to keep the heart symmetrical.

Finish the round with a slip stitch.

Fasten off if changing colors.

Step 5 – Round 4 (Color B)

Join Color B again.

This round defines the outer heart.

Work:

- dc groups
- chain spaces
- increases at the upper curves
- decreases (dc2tog) where shown in the center indentation

Pay close attention to both top lobes so they remain identical.

Continue around the heart until reaching the bottom point.

Join with a slip stitch.

Step 6 – Round 5 (Color A)

Attach Color A for the final border.

Crochet around the entire heart following the chart.

The border combines:

- Double Crochet
- Treble Crochet
- Chain stitches
- dc2tog decreases

At the bottom point of the heart, work the stitches exactly as shown to create a sharp, clean tip.

At the top center, use the indicated **dc2tog** stitches to maintain the heart indentation.

Complete the round.

Join with a slip stitch.

Fasten off.

Weave in all yarn ends using a yarn needle.

✨ **Finishing**

Lay the heart flat.

Lightly steam block or wet block if needed.

Allow it to dry completely before using.

Your finished **Granny Heart Crochet Pattern** can now be used as:

- Granny square centerpiece
- Baby blanket motif
- Pillow decoration
- Wall hanging
- Valentine's Day décor
- Tote bag panel
- Table runner motif
- Cushion cover
- Garland
- Crochet applique
