


Fabric Bunny Sewing Pattern – Complete Step by Step Tutorial

This professional tutorial teaches you how to sew a charming fabric bunny using a simple pattern. The bunny features long ears, a soft stuffed body, and adorable clothing including a shirt and overalls. This project is perfect for handmade gifts, nursery decor, or craft fairs.

Finished Bunny Example




Materials Needed

- Main fabric for bunny body (linen, cotton, or textured fabric)
- Fabric for shirt (light cotton or striped fabric)
- Corduroy or similar fabric for overalls
- Polyester stuffing
- Matching sewing thread
- Embroidery thread for nose

- Black beads or safety eyes
- Thin wire or thread for whiskers (optional)
- Elastic for pants hem
- Fabric scissors
- Sewing pins
- Sewing machine or hand sewing needle

Step 1 – Preparing the Pattern

Print the bunny pattern at 100% scale. Carefully cut out each pattern piece including the ears, the combined head/body piece, the shirt, and the overalls. These pieces will be used as templates to trace onto your fabric.



Step 2 – Cutting the Fabric

Place the pattern pieces onto your chosen fabrics and pin them securely. Cut around each template leaving approximately 0.5 cm seam allowance.

- Cut 2 pieces for the bunny body (mirror images).
- Cut 4 pieces for the ears.
- Cut 2 pieces for the shirt (front and back on fold if desired).
- Cut the overalls piece and two straps.

Step 3 – Sewing the Bunny Body

Place the two body pieces together with right sides facing each other. Sew around the edges leaving a small opening for turning and stuffing. Clip curves carefully to help the shape sit smoothly when turned.


- Turn the body right side out.
- Stuff gradually using polyester fiberfill.
- Close the opening with a ladder stitch.
- Attach the ears to the top of the head.

Step 4 – Making the Face

Sew or attach small black beads for the eyes. Embroider a small triangular nose using embroidery thread. Add whiskers using thin thread or fishing line if desired for extra character.

Step 5 – Sewing the Clothing

The bunny outfit consists of a small shirt and corduroy overalls. These garments give the bunny its charming handmade style.



- Sew the shoulder seams of the shirt.
- Attach sleeves and close the side seams.
- Hem the bottom of the shirt.
- Sew the overalls piece and attach straps.
- Insert elastic at the pant hem to create a gathered look.
- Attach small buttons to secure the straps.

Final Assembly

Once the bunny body and clothing are finished, dress the bunny carefully. You can stitch the arms through the body so they are slightly movable. Adjust the ears and clothing until the bunny has the desired shape and personality.

Tips for a Professional Result

- Use natural fabrics like linen for a beautiful texture.
- Press fabric pieces before sewing for accuracy.
- Stuff the bunny gradually to avoid lumps.
- Use strong thread for attaching limbs.
