

Crochet Cat Paper Clip Pattern 🐱

These adorable crochet cat paper clips are quick, beginner-friendly, and perfect for bookmarks, planners, journals, or handmade gifts. Based on the diagram shown in the image, this tutorial follows the same round construction and ear placement so your finished cat faces stay consistent with the original design. harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com

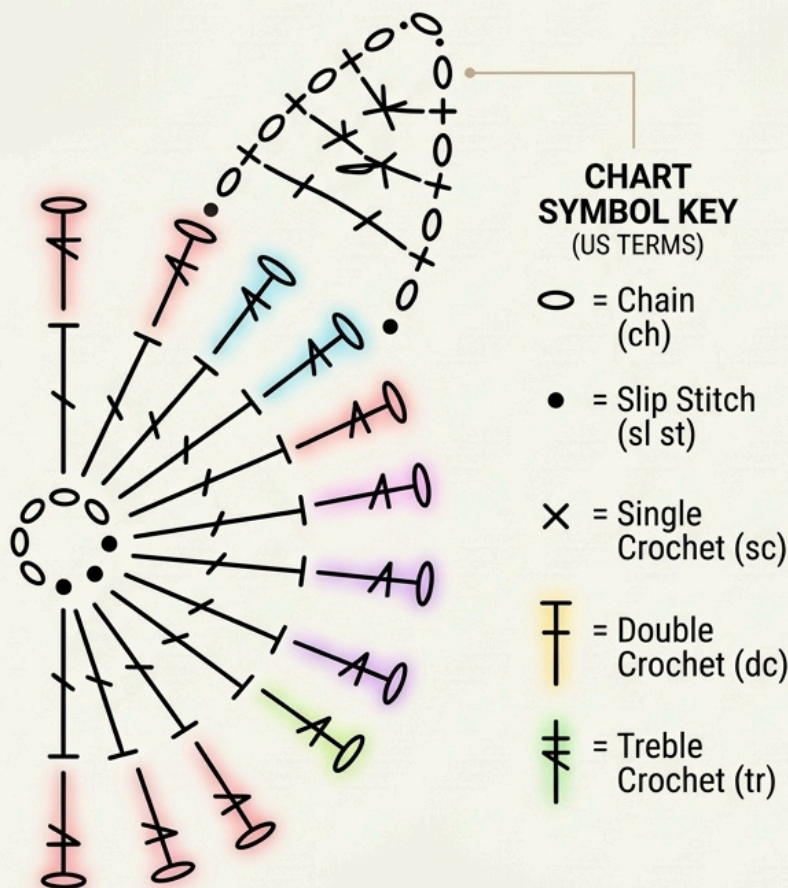
The pattern is written in simple U.S. crochet terms and explained step by step so anyone can make them from start to finish.

DETAILED PATTERN CHART



STEP-BY-STEP WRITTEN PATTERN & VISUAL GUIDE

1. MATERIALS:



2. PART 1: CAT HEAD (CIRCLE)



Start with Magic Ring.
Row 1: Ch 2 (counts as dc), 11 dc.
 Join with sl st.
 Total 12 st.

3. PART 2: FORMING EARS



Step 2.1 (Left Ear):
 Ch 4. From 2nd ch, sc, hdc, dc. Skip 1 st on head, sl st into next st.



Step 2.2 (Right Ear):
 Sl st 1 to position, Ch 4. From 2nd ch, sc, hdc, dc. Skip 1 st on head, sl st into next st.

4. PART 3: ATTACHING & FACIAL EMBROIDERY



Step 3.1: Glue large paperclip to the back.



Step 3.2: With embroidery thread, stitch curved eyes and three horizontal whiskers for each cheek.

5. FINAL PRODUCT

Repeat for different colors.

Materials You Will Need harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com

- Worsted weight cotton yarn or acrylic yarn
- Crochet hook size 3.0 mm to 4.0 mm
- Large metal paper clips
- Yarn needle
- Small scissors
- Black embroidery thread
- Pink yarn or pink embroidery thread
- Hot glue or fabric glue (optional)

Suggested Colors

- Gray
- Cream
- Beige
- Pink
- Brown

Crochet Abbreviations (U.S. Terms) harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com

- MR = Magic Ring
- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- dc = double crochet
- st = stitch
- inc = increase (2 stitches in same stitch)

Starting the Cat Face Base

The cat face is worked in a circle first, then the ears are added directly onto the top of the circle.

Round 1

Make a magic ring.

Work:

- 12 dc inside the magic ring

Pull the ring closed tightly.

Join with a sl st into the first dc.

You should now have a small round circle. harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com

Round 2 – Expanding the Face

Chain 2.

Work:

- 2 dc in each stitch around

You should end with:

- 24 dc total

Join with a sl st. [harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com](https://www.harmonythreads.com/dicasdorei.com)

The circle should now look full and slightly rounded, similar to the diagram.

Creating the First Ear 🦻

The ears are worked directly into the top part of the circle.

Locate the upper left side of the cat head. [harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com](https://www.harmonythreads.com/dicasdorei.com)

Ear Step

In one stitch, work:

- sc
- hdc
- dc
- hdc
- sc

This creates a pointed ear shape.

Slip stitch into the next stitch to secure.

Creating the Second Ear 🦻

Skip several stitches across the top of the head until you reach the opposite side.

Repeat the same ear pattern:

- sc
- hdc
- dc
- hdc
- sc

Slip stitch to secure. harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com

Fasten off and weave in the yarn tail.

At this stage, your crochet piece should resemble a cute cat face with two ears.

Shaping and Adjusting the Cat Face ✨

Use your fingers to gently shape the ears so they point upward.

If the ears curl:

- lightly flatten them
- or steam block carefully

Do not overheat acrylic yarn.

Cotton yarn usually holds the shape very well without blocking.

Embroidering the Eyes 🐱

Using black embroidery thread:

Create two curved lines for sleepy eyes.

The eyes should angle slightly upward toward the ears. harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com

Tips:

- Keep both eyes evenly spaced
- Use small stitches
- Make gentle curved shapes instead of straight lines

This gives the cat a smiling expression.

Adding the Nose and Whiskers 💖

Using pink yarn or embroidery floss:

Make a tiny triangle or small oval nose in the center.

Then use black thread to stitch:

- three whiskers on each side

Keep whiskers short for a cleaner appearance.

Attaching the Paper Clip 📎

You can attach the cat in two different ways.

Method 1 – Sewing

Place the top end of the paper clip behind the crochet face. harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com

Use matching yarn to sew the clip securely onto the back.

This method is durable and neat.

Method 2 – Glue Method

Apply a small amount of hot glue or fabric glue.

Press the crochet piece firmly onto the paper clip.

Allow it to dry completely before using.

Beginner Tips for Better Results

Keep Your Tension Even harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com

Loose stitches may make the face floppy.

Tighter stitches help the cat keep its shape.

Use Cotton Yarn for Best Structure

Cotton yarn gives:

- cleaner stitch definition
- firmer ears
- better durability

Make Multiple Colors

These paper clips are addictive to make and look beautiful in sets.

Try:

- pastel shades
- realistic cat colors
- rainbow collections

Making the Cats Larger or Smaller

To make a larger cat:

- use thicker yarn
- use a larger hook

To make a smaller cat: harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com

- use fine cotton thread
- use a smaller hook

Mini versions look adorable for:

- tiny planners
- doll accessories
- keychains

Customization Ideas

You can personalize your cat clips with:

- Tiny bows
- Glasses embroidery
- Different eye expressions
- Stripes
- Tiny flowers
- Sparkle yarn
- Heart-shaped noses

Common Beginner Mistakes and Fixes

Ears Look Uneven

Count stitches carefully before starting the second ear.

Circle Is Curling

Your tension may be too tight.

Try using a slightly larger hook.

Paper Clip Feels Loose

Sew through the metal clip several times for extra security.

Face Looks Crooked

Flatten the circle before attaching the clip.

Blocking also helps improve symmetry.
