## CROCHET FLOWER BRACELET

### STEP-BY-STEP WITH PHOTOS

Adjustable • Beginner Friendly • Handmade with Love 

**MATERIALS**


- Cotton yarn:
  - Green (approx. 15g)
  - Red (approx. 5g)
  - Yellow (small amount)
- Crochet hook: 2.5 mm (or size needed to obtain desired tension)
- Scissors
- Yarn needle (tapestry needle)

**ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)**

ch = chain  
 sl st = slip stitch  
 sc = single crochet  
 hdc = half double crochet  
 dc = double crochet  
 tr = treble crochet  
 MR = magic ring  
 ( ) = work stitches in the same stitch  
 [ ] = repeat instructions in brackets

**FINISHED SIZE**

Adjustable  
 one size fits most.  
 Bracelet band width:  
 approx. 0.5 cm

## HOW TO MAKE


**1 FLOWER CENTER (YELLOW)**

R1: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), 6 sc into the ring. Pull the ring tight. Sl st to first sc. (6 sc)




**2 FLOWER PETALS (RED)**

R2: Join red yarn in any st. Ch 1, 2 sc in the same st, (skip next st, 3 sc in next st) repeat around. You will have 6 petals. Sl st to first sc.




**3 FINISH FLOWER**

Fasten off, leave a long tail. Use the yarn needle to weave in the ends. Your flower is ready!




**4 MAKE THE CORDS (GREEN)**

Cut 2 pieces of green yarn, each approx. 70 cm (28 in). Fold each piece in half. These will be your cords.




**5 ATTACH FLOWER TO CORDS**

Place the flower in the middle. Take one cord, fold it, and pull the loop through the back of the flower. Pull both ends through the loop and tighten. Repeat with the other cord on the opposite side.




**6 SIDE KNOTS (SECURE)**

Make a simple overhand knot on each side of the flower to secure it.




**7 SLIDING ADJUSTABLE KNOT**

Use both cord ends together. Make a loop crossing one cord over the other. Pull one end through the loop. Hold the knot and pull both ends to tighten. This is your sliding knot.




**8 CORD END BOBBLES**

To prevent fraying and add a cute touch: R1: At the end of each cord, make a small bobble. Ch 2, 3 dc in 2nd ch from hook, sl st into first dc. Pull tight. Fasten off and hide the tail.









**9 FINISHED BRACELET**


Adjust the sliding knot to fit your wrist. Your bracelet is ready to wear! Enjoy your handmade piece!




**US CROCHET STITCH GUIDE (With Photos)**

Chain (ch)	Slip Stitch (sl st)	Single Crochet (sc)	Half Double Crochet (hdc)	Double Crochet (dc)	Treble Crochet (tr)
					
Yarn over, pull through loop.	Insert hook, pull yarn through all loops.	Insert hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through both loops.	Yarn over, insert hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through all 3 loops.	Yarn over, insert hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops.	Yarn over twice, insert hook, yarn over, pull through, (yarn over, pull through 2 loops) 3 times.

**TIPS & NOTES**





- Keep your stitches not too tight for a soft bracelet.
- You can adjust the cord length for a smaller or larger fit.
- Use cotton yarn for best results.
- Make the flower in different colors to match your style! 

**METHOD OVERVIEW**

1. Crochet the flower (center + petals).
2. Attach the flower to the green cords.
3. Secure with side knots.
4. Make a sliding adjustable knot.
5. Add bobbles to the ends.
6. Adjust and enjoy! 


**CARE INSTRUCTIONS**


- Hand wash gently.
- Lay flat to dry.
- Do not bleach.
- Iron on low if needed.

This **crochet flower bracelet** is a delicate adjustable bracelet made with thin green cords, a red flower, yellow center, and two small green leaves. It is perfect for beginners who already know basic crochet stitches and want to make a cute handmade accessory.

## Materials Needed [The Best Crochet Patterns: harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com](http://harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com)

You will need mercerized cotton yarn or thin crochet thread in **green, red, and yellow**. Use green for the bracelet cords and leaves, red for the flower petals, and yellow for the center.


Use a **1.75 mm crochet hook**, scissors, and a tapestry needle. For a delicate bracelet like the photo, choose thin thread, such as size 295 or similar.

### CROCHET FLOWER BRACELET WITH CHART



### FLOWER CHART

(Make 1 flower)



**Center (yellow)**  
 Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring  
 Rnd 2: 12 sc (2 sc in each st)

**Petals (red)**  
 Rnd 3: \* 1 sc in next st, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc in next st \*  
 Repeat from \* to \* 5 times.  
 Sl st to first sc to close.

**Leaves (green)**  
 Make 2 leaves.  
 Ch 6.  
 Rnd 1: Starting from 2nd ch from hook: 1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc.  
 Rnd 2: 1 sc in each st.  
 Fasten off.

**MATERIALS**


- Mercerized cotton yarn:
  - Green (for cord and leaves)
  - Red (for petals)
  - Yellow (for center)
- Crochet hook 1.75 mm
- Scissors
- Tapestry needle

**STITCH KEY (TERMS USED)**

- = chain (ch)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- + = single crochet (sc)
- ⏏ = half double crochet (hdc)
- ⏏ = double crochet (dc)
- ⏏ = treble crochet (tr)
- = magic ring
- ↪ = repeat

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**BRACELET CORD**  
 Make 2 cords with green yarn.  
 Each cord: Ch 60.





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**STEP-BY-STEP**


**1 - CENTER**  
 Make the center with yellow yarn.




**2 - PETALS**  
 Work the petals around the center with red yarn.




**3 - LEAVES**  
 Make 2 green leaves and attach them to the sides of the flower.



**4 - CORDS**  
 Attach the green cords to each side of the flower (as shown in the photo).



**5 - ENDS**  
 Make small knots at the ends (optional).




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**FINISHING AND ADJUSTMENT**  
 Make a sliding knot in the center of the back of the bracelet to adjust the size.

To make the sliding knot:

1. Make a simple knot.
2. Pass one end through the knot.
3. Pull both ends to adjust the size.

## Stitch Abbreviations Used

ch = chain

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sc = single crochet

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tr = treble crochet

MR = magic ring

st = stitch

## Step 1: Make the Yellow Flower Center

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With yellow yarn, make a **magic ring**.

Round 1: Work **6 sc into the magic ring**. Pull the ring closed and join with a sl st to the first sc.

Round 2: Work **2 sc in each stitch around**. You should have **12 sc** total. Join with a sl st and fasten off.

This small yellow circle will be the center of the flower. Keep your stitches tight so the center looks neat and round.

## Step 2: Crochet the Red Petals

Join red yarn into any stitch of the yellow center.

For each petal, work this sequence into the stitches around the center:

**1 sc in next st, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc**

Repeat this pattern **5 times** to create 5 rounded petals. Join with a sl st to the first stitch and fasten off.

Shape the petals gently with your fingers so the flower looks full and even.

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## Step 3: Make the Green Leaves

Make **2 leaves** using green yarn.

Chain 6.

Starting in the second chain from the hook, work:

**1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc**

Now work on the opposite side of the chain to shape the leaf:

**1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc**

Join with a sl st, fasten off, and leave a yarn tail for sewing.

Make the second leaf the same way.

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## Step 4: Sew the Leaves to the Flower

Place one green leaf on each side of the red flower. The leaves should sit slightly behind the petals, just like in the photo.

Using a tapestry needle and green yarn tails, sew the leaves securely to the back of the flower. Make sure the front looks clean and the leaves are balanced on both sides.

## Step 5: Make the Bracelet Cords

With green yarn, make **2 cords**.

For each cord, chain about **60 chains**. This length fits most wrists and allows the bracelet to be adjustable.

Suggested finished size: adjustable from about **5.5 to 8.7 inches / 14 to 22 cm**.

After making both cords, attach one cord to each side of the flower and leaves. Sew or tie them firmly so the flower stays centered on the bracelet.

## Step 6: Make the Adjustable Sliding Knot

Bring the cord ends together at the back of the bracelet.

Wrap one cord around the other cords several times to create a small sliding knot. Secure it with a tight knot, then test the bracelet by pulling both ends.

The bracelet should open and close smoothly.

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## Step 7: Add the Small Red End Flowers

At each cord end, make a small red knot or tiny crochet ball.

A simple option is to make a small red bead-like end:

Make a magic ring with red yarn, work **6 sc into the ring**, pull tight, and close. Sew or knot it onto the cord end.

Repeat for the other end.

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## Finishing Tips ✨

Hide all yarn tails with a tapestry needle. Trim carefully.

Adjust the bracelet on your wrist and make sure the sliding knot moves easily. The flower should sit in the center, with the two green cords creating a delicate double-band look. Your
