

Crochet Rose Hand Chain Bracelet Tutorial 🌹



This crochet rose hand chain bracelet is a delicate jewelry-style project made with a green crochet chain base, small leaves, red crochet roses, gold beads, a bracelet closure, and a finger loop. The design connects around the wrist and extends down the hand to create a beautiful floral ring bracelet. **THE BEST CROCHET PATTERNS:** 👉 [HERE](#) 👉

Materials Needed

Use cotton crochet thread or fine yarn in olive green and deep red. For a jewelry look, size 10 crochet cotton works very well.

You will also need a small steel crochet hook, gold beads, jump rings, lobster clasp, chain extender, yarn needle, scissors, and jewelry pliers.


Suggested hook size for U.S. makers: 1.25 mm to 1.75 mm, depending on your thread thickness. **THE BEST CROCHET PATTERNS:** [👉 HERE 👉](#)

CROCHET ROSE BRACELET

Chart and Step-by-Step Tutorial

MATERIALS

- Fine cotton crochet thread (e.g., Aunt Lydia's, Lizbeth, or similar)
 - Green: 1 small ball
 - Red: 1 small ball
- Crochet hook:
 - 1.25 mm or 1.5 mm
- Gold beads (3 mm)
- Lobster clasp with extension chain
- Scissors and tapestry needle




STITCHES USED


- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
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ABBREVIATIONS

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1. ROSE (Center and Pendant)
Make 2 roses (1 for the center and 1 for the pendant).



Rnd 1: Magic Ring, work 6 sc into the ring.
Rnd 2: 2 sc in each stitch around. (12 sts)
Rnd 3: *1 sc, 2 sc in next stitch* around. (18 sts)
Rnd 4: 1 sc in each stitch around. (18 sts)
Rnd 5: *1 sc, 2 sc in next stitch* around. (24 sts)
Rnd 6: 1 sc in each stitch around. (24 sts)
Rnd 7: *1 tr, 2 tr in next stitch* around. (36 sts)
Rnd 8: 1 tr in each stitch around. (36 sts)
 Fasten off and shape the rose by rolling the petals inward.


2. LEAF (Make 6)
Start with 7 chains.

Row 1 (right side):
Work along the chain:
1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc


Row 2 (wrong side):
1 ch, turn.
1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc

Row 3 (right side):
1 ch, turn.
1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc

Fasten off and gently shape the leaf.




3. BRACELET BASE (Base chain with leaves and beads)
Make a chain approximately 16–18 cm (6¼–7 in) long, adjusting to fit the wrist. Place the motifs in this order:




Suggested spacing:
2–3 cm between decorative elements

Repeat the sequence as needed while maintaining symmetry.


4. PENDANT (Hanging Section)
Attach 1 leaf beneath the center rose.
Below the leaf:
• Add 1 bead
• Attach the smaller rose
Finish with a small chain loop to form the decorative drop.



5. FINISHING
At each end of the bracelet:
• Attach 1 lobster clasp
• Add 1 extension chain (5–7 cm / 2–3 in)
Weave in all yarn ends securely.



COMPLETE ASSEMBLY SUMMARY



HELPFUL TIPS



- Use fine crochet thread and a small hook for a delicate jewelry finish.
- Adjust the bracelet length to fit your wrist comfortably.
- Lightly steam-block the roses and leaves for a polished appearance.
- Add extra beads for a more elegant look.
- Metallic crochet thread can create a luxury jewelry effect.

SUGGESTED FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

- Bracelet length: 16–18 cm (6¼–7 in) plus 5–7 cm (2–3 in) extension chain
- Center rose diameter: 3 cm (1.2 in)
- Pendant rose diameter: 1.5 cm (0.6 in)

Abbreviations used in U.S. terms:

ch = chain

sl st = slip stitch

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tr = treble crochet

st = stitch

Step 1: Make the Green Bracelet Base

Start with the olive green thread.

Crochet a chain long enough to fit around the wrist. For an average adult size, make about 15–17 cm, but measure around the wrist before finishing.

Work back across the chain with slip stitches or single crochet to make the cord stronger and thicker.

This will be the main bracelet band where the leaves and large rose will be attached.

Step 2: Crochet the Small Leaves

To make one leaf, chain 6.

Starting in the second chain from the hook, make:

1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 1 hdc, then work on the other side of the chain with 1 hdc, 2 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc.

Slip stitch at the base and fasten off.

Make several small leaves in green. The bracelet in the image has leaves on both sides of the rose, so make at least 6 to 8 leaves.

Step 3: Add Leaves to the Bracelet Band

Place the leaves along the bracelet base. **THE BEST CROCHET PATTERNS:** [👉 HERE 👈](#)

Attach them in pairs, one leaf pointing upward and one pointing downward.

Sew them carefully with green thread so they look like small vines growing from the bracelet.

Leave the center area open for the large rose.

Step 4: Add Gold Beads

Thread small gold beads onto the green thread or sew them on after crocheting.

Place beads between leaves and near the rose area.

The beads give the bracelet a more elegant jewelry finish.

Secure each bead tightly so it does not move too much when worn.

Step 5: Crochet the Large Red Rose

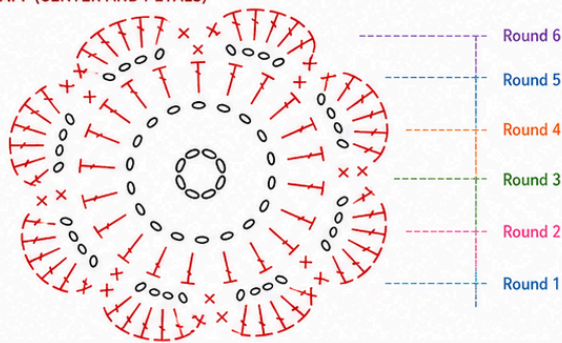

STITCH LEGEND (US TERMS)

- = chain (ch)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- × = single crochet (sc)
- ⌣ = half double crochet (hdc)
- ⌣ = double crochet (dc)
- ⌣ = treble crochet (tr)
- = magic ring (mr)

STEP-BY-STEP – ROSE

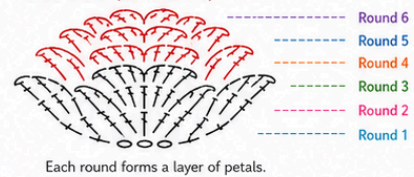
ROUND	DIAGRAM	STITCHES	HOW TO MAKE	TOTAL STITCHES
Round 1		6 sc in mr	Make 6 single crochets in the magic ring.	6 sc
Round 2		6 sc	Make 1 sc in each stitch around.	6 sc
Round 3		12 dc	Make 2 dc in each stitch around (6 times).	12 dc
Round 4		(1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc) in each stitch around	In each stitch of the previous round, make: 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc.	24 dc + 12 ch
Round 5		(2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in each ch-1 space	In each ch-1 space of the previous round, make: 2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc.	48 dc + 12 ch
Round 6		(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in each ch-1 space	In each ch-1 space of the previous round, make: 3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc.	72 dc + 12 ch

TIPS

- Use fine cotton yarn and a suitable hook for a delicate finish.
- Adjust the tension of your stitches so the petals are well shaped.
- Finish off and weave in the ends on the first stitch.

ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)

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- mr = magic ring

SUGGESTED MATERIALS

- Fine cotton yarn (e.g., size 10 crochet thread)
- Crochet hook: 1.25 mm or 1.5 mm
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

FINISHED MEASUREMENT (APPROX.)

- Rose diameter: ~3 cm (1.2 in)
- (Varies depending on yarn and tension)
- Each petal layer adds volume and shape.

With red thread, chain 26 to 35, depending on how large you want the rose.

In the second chain from the hook, work a base row of single crochet.

For the petal row, repeat across:

sl st, 3 dc in the next stitch, sl st in the next stitch.

This creates a spiral strip of petals.

Roll the strip into a rose shape, starting from one end.

Sew through the bottom of the rose several times to hold it firmly.

Step 6: Attach the Large Rose

Place the large red rose in the center of the bracelet.

Sew it firmly onto the green base.

Add leaves around the rose, just like in the image.

You can also sew small gold beads around the rose for decoration.

Step 7: Make the Hand Chain Extension

From the bottom center of the bracelet, crochet a green chain that reaches toward the middle finger.

Measure from the wrist to the base of the finger.

For most adult hands, this section is around 8–10 cm.

Work slip stitches back across the chain to make it stronger.

Step 8: Crochet the Small Rose

Make a smaller red rose using fewer chains, about 14 to 18 chains.

Use the same petal method:

sl st, 3 dc, sl st repeat.

Roll the strip into a small rose and sew it closed.

Attach this small rose to the hand chain extension. Add 2 or 3 green leaves below it.

Step 9: Make the Finger Loop

At the end of the hand chain, crochet a loop large enough to fit around the finger comfortably.

Chain about 16 to 22 stitches, depending on finger size.

Join with a slip stitch to form a loop.

Work one round of slip stitches or single crochet around the loop to make it firm.

Do not make it too tight. It should slide on and off easily.

Step 10: Add the Bracelet Closure

Attach a small jump ring to one end of the bracelet.

Attach a lobster clasp to the other end.

Add a gold chain extender if you want the bracelet to be adjustable.

Sew or connect all metal parts securely.

Step 11: Final Assembly

Check the full bracelet layout.

The large rose should sit at the center of the wrist.

The hand chain should fall neatly down the center of the hand.

The small rose should sit between the wrist and finger loop.

The finger loop should rest comfortably around the finger.

Finishing Tips

THE BEST CROCHET PATTERNS:  [HERE](#) 

Weave in all thread ends with a yarn needle.

Block the leaves and roses lightly with steam or fabric stiffener if needed.

Shape each leaf with your fingers while drying.

Make sure all beads and flowers are firmly attached.

Your crochet rose hand chain bracelet is ready to wear.
