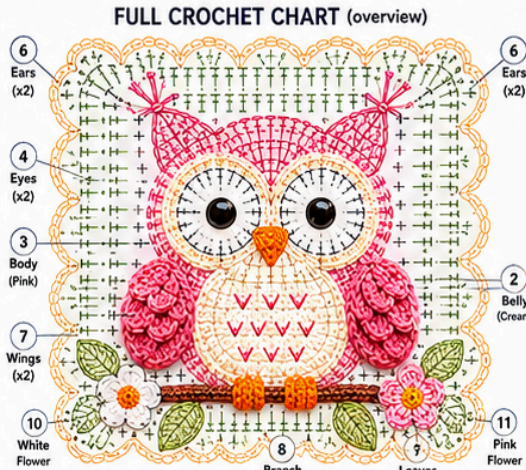

DETAILED CROCHET PATTERN – OWL GRANNY SQUARE

Complete Step-by-Step Guide with Stitches, Counts, Measurements and Assembly



STITCH LEGEND (US TERMS)

- = chain (ch)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- +
- ⊥ = single crochet (sc)
- ⊥ = half double crochet (hdc)
- ⊥ = double crochet (dc)
- ⊥ = treble crochet (tr)
- ∨ = 2 dc in the same stitch (increase)
- ∧ = 2 sc together (decrease)
- Ⓞ = circle = start of round (magic ring)
- = direction of work

MATERIALS

- 100% cotton yarn (DK / Light worsted #3)
- Sage Green (Background)
- Pink (Owl body, wings, ears)
- Cream (Border, eyes, belly)
- Orange (Beak, feet, flower center)
- Brown (Branch)
- Green (Leaves)
- White (Large flower)
- Pink (Small flower petals)

TOOLS

- 2.5–3.0 mm crochet hook
- Safety eyes 15 mm (x2)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Stitch markers

1. BACKGROUND (SAGE GREEN) – 5 ROUNDS

- R1: MR, 12 dc. sl st to join. (12)
 R2: ch 2, 2 dc in each st. (24)
 R3: ch 2, *1 dc, 2 dc in next st* around. (36)
 R4: ch 2, *2 dc, 2 dc in next st* around. (48)
 R5: ch 1, sc in each st around. (48)



2. SCALLOP BORDER (CREAM)

Work on the edge: [skip 1 st, 5 dc in next st, skip 1 st, sl st in next st]. Repeat all around. Fasten off and weave in ends.



3. OWL BODY (PINK) – 6 ROUNDS (MR 6 sc)

- R1: 6 sc
 R2: inc around (12)
 R3: (1 sc, inc) around (18)
 R4: (2 sc, inc) around (24)
 R5: (3 sc, inc) around (30)
 R6: (4 sc, inc) around (36)



4. EYES (make 2) – CREAM

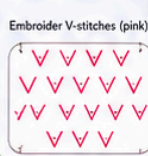
- R1: MR 8 sc (8)
 R2: inc around (16)
 R3: (1 sc, inc) around (24)



Attach safety eyes 15 mm in the center. Add eyelashes with black yarn (3 sts each).

5. BELLY (CREAM)

- R1: MR 6 sc (6)
 R2: inc around (12)
 R3: (1 sc, inc) around (18)
 R4: (2 sc, inc) around (24)
 R5: (3 sc, inc) around (30)



Embroider V-stitches (pink):

6. BEAK (ORANGE)

Triangular shape

- R1: ch 4
 R2: sc 3
 R3: dec, sc (2)
 R4: dec (1)

Fasten off. Sew between the eyes.



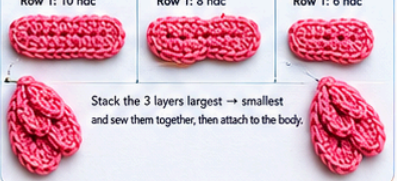
7. EARS (make 2) – PINK

Ch 10, turn.
 Row 1: sc across (9)
 R3: dec, sc (2)
 R4: dec (1)
 Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Make a small tassel: cut 6 strands (6–7 cm), tie in the center and attach to the tip of each ear.



8. WINGS (make 2) – 3 LAYERS (PINK)

- | Layer 1 (Feather 1) | Layer 2 (Feather 2) | Layer 3 (Feather 3) |
|---------------------|---------------------|---------------------|
| Ch 12 | Ch 10 | Ch 8 |
| Row 1: 10 hdc | Row 1: 8 hdc | Row 1: 6 hdc |



Stack the 3 layers largest → smallest and sew them together, then attach to the body.

9. BRANCH (BROWN)

Ch 25, turn.
 Row 1: sc across (24)
 Fasten off.
 Sew at the bottom of the owl.



10. LEAVES (make 6) – GREEN

Ch 8.
 Row 1 (one side): sc, hdc, dc, dc, hdc, sc.
 Row 2 (other side): sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc.
 Sl st to close. Fasten off.



11. FLOWERS

LARGE FLOWER (WHITE)
 Center (orange): MR 6 sc (6)
 Petal (x5): *ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, sl st into next st*



SMALL FLOWER (PINK)
 Center (orange): MR 6 sc (6)
 Petal (x5): *ch 2, 2 hdc, ch 2, sl st into next st*



12. ASSEMBLY – HOW TO PUT EVERYTHING TOGETHER



- 1 Background (sage green)
- 2 = Scallop border (cream)
- 3 = Owl body (pink)
- 4 = Eyes (cream + safety eyes)
- 5 = Belly (cream)
- 6 = Beak (orange)
- 7 = Ears (pink with tassels)
- 8 = Wings (pink, 3 layers)
- 9 = Branch (brown)
- 10 = Leaves (green)
- 11 = Large flower (white)
- 12 = Small flower (pink)

FINAL MEASUREMENTS: 10 cm x 10 cm (4 in x 4 in)

HOOK SIZE: 2.5 – 3.0 mm

YARN: 100% cotton

GAUGE (approx): 24 sc x 26 rows = 10 cm (4 in)

Materials You Need

The Best Crochet Patterns: harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com

Use worsted weight cotton yarn in **pink/rose, cream, orange, sage green, brown, white, and yellow.**

You will also need a **3.5 mm crochet hook**, two **8 mm safety eyes**, yarn needle, scissors, stitch marker, and optional glue for securing small parts.

Abbreviations: **MR** magic ring, **ch** chain, **sl st** slip stitch, **sc** single crochet, **hdc** half double crochet, **dc** double crochet, **tr** treble crochet, **inc** increase, **dec** decrease.

CROCHET CHART – OWL SQUARE

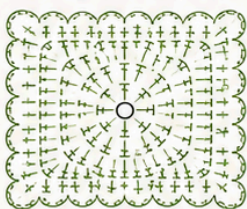
Stitches used: chain (ch), slip stitch (sl st), single crochet (sc), half double crochet (hdc), double crochet (dc)



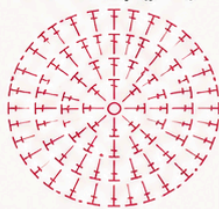
LEGEND:

- = chain (ch)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- +
- ⋈ = single crochet (sc)
- ⋈ = half double crochet (hdc)
- ⋈ = double crochet (dc)
- ⋈ = treble crochet (tr)
- ∨ = 2 dc in the same stitch (increase)
- Λ = 2 sc together (decrease)
- ⊞ = start of work (magic ring)

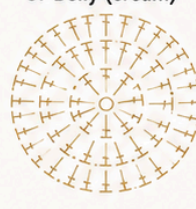
1. Background (square)



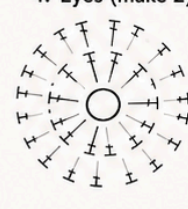
2. Owl Body (pink)

Step 1: Crochet the Scalloped Background

With sage green yarn, make a **magic ring**.

Round 1: Ch 1, make **10 sc** into the ring, pull tight, sl st to join. **[10]**

Round 2: Ch 1, make **2 sc in each stitch** around, sl st to join. **[20]**

Round 3: Ch 1, repeat **sc in next st, inc in next st** around, sl st to join. **[30]**

For the scalloped edge: repeat around: **sl st, ch 3, sl st in next st, skip 1 st, sl st in next st**. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Step 2: Crochet the Cream Owl Body

With cream yarn, ch 10.

Starting in the 2nd chain from hook, make **8 sc**, then make **3 sc in the last chain**.

Work on the opposite side of the chain with **8 sc**, then increase at the end. Continue working around until the oval body looks full and even.

Suggested final round: sc around, placing increases at the curved ends. Aim for about **24 stitches**.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Add small pink or rose **V-stitches** on the belly using embroidery-style stitches.

Step 3: Crochet the Pink Head and Ears

With pink yarn, make a magic ring.

Round 1: Ch 1, make **6 sc** into the ring, sl st to join. **[6]**

Round 2: Make **2 sc in each stitch** around. **[12]**

Round 3: Repeat **sc, inc** around. **[18]**

Round 4: Sc around. **[18]**

To make the ears, work this shape at both top sides: **sl st, ch 6, sl st in 2nd chain from hook, sc, hdc, dc, sl st back into the head**. Repeat on the other side.

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

CROCHET PATTERN – OWL GRANNY SQUARE

DETAILED STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE



FINISHED SIZE

Approx. 10 x 10 cm
(4 x 4 in)

MATERIALS

- Cotton yarn (DK / 8 ply)
- Colors:
 - Pink (owl)
 - Cream (belly, eyes, border, big flower)
 - Green (background, leaves)
 - Brown (branch)
 - Orange (beak, feet, flower center)
 - Yellow (flower center)
 - Black (embroidery for eyelashes)
- 3.0 mm crochet hook
- Safety eyes 15 mm (2 pcs)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Stitch markers (optional)



Cotton DK



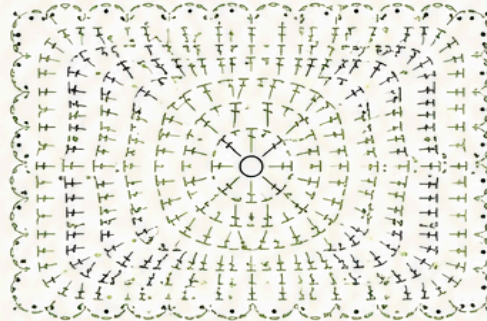

- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet

1. BACKGROUND (GREEN) – SQUARE

Round	Instructions	Stitches
1	MR, 12 dc into ring, sl st to first dc	12
2	ch 2, 2 dc in each st around, sl st	24
3	ch 2, *1 dc, 2 dc in next st*, repeat, sl st	36
4	ch 2, *2 dc, 2 dc in next st*, repeat, sl st	48
5	ch 1, sc in each st around, sl st	48

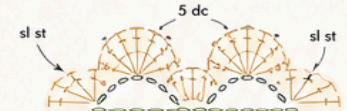


2. SCALLOPED BORDER (CREAM)

Join cream yarn in any stitch.

Repeat around:

(skip 1 st, 5 dc in next st, skip 1 st, sl st in next st)

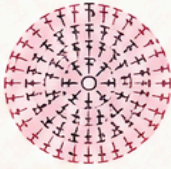


3. OWL BODY (PINK)

Make 1

- R1: MR, 6 sc (6)
- R2: inc around (12)
- R3: (1 sc, inc) x6 (18)
- R4: (2 sc, inc) x6 (24)
- R5: (3 sc, inc) x6 (30)
- R6: (4 sc, inc) x6 (36)

Fasten off.



4. BELLY (CREAM)

Make 1

- R1: MR, 6 sc (6)
- R2: inc around (12)
- R3: (1 sc, inc) x6 (18)
- R4: (2 sc, inc) x6 (24)
- R5: (3 sc, inc) x6 (30)

Fasten off.



5. EYES (CREAM) – Make 2

- R1: MR, 8 sc (8)
- R2: inc around (16)
- R3: (1 sc, inc) x8 (24)

Fasten off.



Attach safety eyes (15 mm)

6. BEAK (ORANGE)

Make 1

- Row 1: ch 4
- Row 2: sc 3 (3)
- Row 3: dec, sc (2)
- Row 4: dec (1)

Fasten off.



Sew between the eyes.

7. EARS (PINK) – Make 2

- Row 1: ch 10
- Row 2: sc back along chain (9)

Fasten off, leave long tail.

Make a tassel with yarn and tie on top of each ear.



8. WINGS (PINK) – Make 2

3 LAYERS (FEATHERS)

Layer 1 (base)	Layer 2	Layer 3 (top)
ch 12	ch 10	ch 8
10 hdc	8 hdc	6 hdc
Fasten off	Fasten off	Fasten off



Stack layers and sew together.

9. BRANCH (BROWN)

Make 1

- ch 25
- Row 1: sc in each ch (24)

Fasten off.



10. LEAVES (GREEN) – Make 8

- Row 1: ch 8
- Row 2: sc, hdc, dc, dc, hdc, sc (6)
- Row 3: sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc (4)
- Row 4: sl st across top.

Fasten off, leave tail.

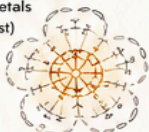


11. BIG FLOWER (CREAM)

Make 1

- Center (yellow)
- R1: MR, 6 sc (6)

Petals (cream) – 5 petals
(ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, sl st)
Repeat 5 times.

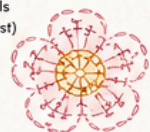


12. SMALL FLOWER (PINK)

Make 1

- Center (yellow)
- R1: MR, 6 sc (6)

Petals (pink) – 5 petals
(ch 2, 2 hdc, ch 2, sl st)
Repeat 5 times.



13. ASSEMBLY

1. Sew belly onto body.
2. Attach eyes and beak.
3. Sew ears on top of head.
4. Sew wings on both sides.
5. Embroider "V" feathers on belly with pink yarn.
6. Sew feet below belly.
7. Sew branch at the bottom.
8. Attach leaves, flowers.
9. Sew the owl to the center of the background square.
10. Add scalloped border.



TIPS

- Use stitch markers to keep your rounds even.
- Weave in all ends neatly.
- Block the square gently for a flat finish.

Step 4: Crochet the Cream Eyes

Make two cream circles. The Best Crochet Patterns: harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com

Round 1: MR, ch 1, make **6 sc**, sl st to join. **[6]**

Round 2: Make **2 sc in each stitch** around. **[12]**

Fasten off. Insert one **8 mm safety eye** in the center of each cream circle.

Sew or glue the eyes onto the pink head. With black yarn, embroider small eyelashes on the outer sides.

Step 5: Crochet the Pink Wings

Make two wings.

Ch 6. Starting in the 2nd chain from hook, work: **hdc, 2 dc, hdc, sc**.

To make the wing fuller, chain 3, sl st into the base, chain 3 again, and sl st into the base. Repeat until the wing has a layered feather look.

Fasten off and make the second wing the same way.

Sew one wing on each side of the cream body.

Step 6: Crochet the Orange Beak and Feet

For the beak: with orange yarn, make MR, ch 1, work **4 sc**, pull tight, shape into a small triangle, and fasten off.

Sew the beak between the eyes.

For each foot: MR, ch 1, make **6 sc**, sl st to join. Add tiny toe stitches if desired. Make two feet.

Sew the feet at the bottom of the body.

Step 7: Crochet the Brown Branch

With brown yarn, ch 20. The Best Crochet Patterns: harmonythreads.dicasdorei.com

Starting in the 2nd chain from hook, make **sc across**.

Fasten off and weave in ends, or leave tails for sewing.

Sew the branch across the bottom of the appliqué, under the owl's feet.

Step 8: Crochet the Flowers and Leaves

For each flower: MR, ch 1, make **6 sc**, sl st to join.

Petals: repeat 5 times: **ch 2, hdc, sl st in same stitch**.

For the flower center, use yellow or white yarn and make a small knot or tiny circle.

For each leaf: ch 6. Starting in the 2nd chain from hook, work **sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc**. Fasten off.

Sew flowers and leaves around the branch and lower background.

Step 9: Assemble the Owl Appliqué

Place the sage background flat.

Sew the cream body in the center.

Sew the pink head slightly overlapping the top of the body.

Attach the eyes, beak, wings, feet, branch, flowers, and leaves.

Use small, neat stitches so the appliqué looks clean from the front.

Step 10: Add the Ear Tufts

Cut **6 strands of pink yarn** and **6 strands of cream yarn**, each about 3 inches long.

Group the strands together and tie them in the center with pink yarn.

Attach one tuft to the top of each ear.

Trim the ends evenly for a soft decorative look.

Final Result

Your **Floral Owl Appliqué** is ready! 🦉🌸
