CROCHET LACE TURBAN WITH LEAF TIE


Step-by-Step Tutorial (US Terms)

FINISHED LOOK



MATERIALS

- Medium (4) weight yarn (approx. 150–200 yards) in main color (MC)
- Crochet hook US 1/9 (5.5 mm)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors




GAUGE
13 dc x 7 rows = 4" (10 cm) in double crochet (dc) stitch.

ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)


ch – chain
sl st – slip stitch
sc – single crochet
hdc – half double crochet
dc – double crochet
tr – treble crochet
dc2tog – double crochet two together
sp – space
st(s) – stitch(es)
MC – main color

STEP 1: CROWN CIRCLE


1 Ch 4, join with sl st to first ch to form a ring.




2 Ch 3 (counts as dc), 11 dc into ring. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. (12 dc)



3 Round 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in each st around. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. (24 dc)



4 Round 3: Ch 3, dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, repeat around. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. (36 dc)




SPECIAL STITCHES


dc2tog (double crochet two together): Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through 2 loops. Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through 3 loops on hook.

STEP 2: LACE PATTERN (TURBAN BODY)


1 Round 4: Ch 3, dc in next 2 st, 2 dc in next st, repeat around. Join with sl st. (48 dc)




2 Round 5: Ch 3, (dc, ch 1, dc) in the same st, *skip next st, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next st*, repeat around. Join with sl st.



3 Round 6: Sl st into ch-1 sp, ch 3, (dc, ch 1, dc) in same sp, *skip next (dc, ch 1, dc) group, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 sp*, repeat around. Join with sl st.




4 Round 7: Repeat Round 6 to increase length until piece measures about 9–10" in diameter (according to head size). Fasten off.




STEP 3: FORM FRONT TWIST


1 Lay the piece flat. Find the center front.




2 Bring the left side edge over the center.




3 Bring the right side edge over the left side at the center.




4 The front should form a twisted knot look.



5 Sew the edges together at the back to secure the turban shape.




6 Turn right side out. The turban body is ready!




STEP 4: LEAF TIE MAKING

A. MAKE LEAVES (Make 12–14 leaves)


1 Ch 7.




2 Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 4 ch, 3 sc in last ch.




3 Working on the other side of the chain: sc in next 4 ch, 2 sc in last ch. (12 sc total)




4 Sl st into first sc. Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.




5 Slightly fold the leaf and sew the base to give shape.






B. MAKE LEAF STRANDS


1 Ch 30 (or desired length for strand).




2 Attach a leaf: Fold the leaf in half and sl st into the chain.




3 Ch 5, attach next leaf. Repeat along the chain.



4 Make 3–4 strands with leaves.




FINISHED TURBAN




Wear it stylishly with the leaf tie draped down the side or back. Adjust the tie for comfort and fit.

C. ASSEMBLE TIE


1 Take 2–4 leaf strands.




2 Tie them together at the base with yarn to form a tassel.



3 Weave the tie through the open lace spaces at the sides of the turban. Tie a bow at the back.





QUICK REFERENCE


- Crown: Start with magic ring or chain ring and work in rounds.
- Body: Use (dc, ch 1, dc) lace rounds and grow evenly.
- Front Twist: Cross front edges for turban style.
- Tie: Crochet leaves and attach to chains for a beautiful tassel tie.

TIPS

- Use soft, breathable yarn for comfort.
- Block the piece lightly for better drape.
- Adjust length and number of lace rounds for fit.
- Add more leaves or beads for extra style!

Materials

You will need:

- Medium (4) Weight Yarn (150–200 yards / 137–183 m)
- Crochet Hook Size I-9 (5.5 mm)
- Yarn Needle
- Stitch Markers (optional)
- Scissors
- Measuring Tape


Finished Size

- Fits most adult head sizes (21–23 inches / 53–58 cm)
- Crown Diameter before folding:
 - Approximately 9–10 inches (23–25 cm)

CROCHET LACE TURBAN PATTERN & STITCH GUIDE (US TERMS)

TURBAN TOP (worked in the round)



STITCH GUIDE (US TERMS)

- = magic ring (MR)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- + = single crochet (sc)
- ⊥ = double crochet (dc)
- ⊥ = treble crochet (tr)
- = chain (ch)

TURBAN INSTRUCTIONS

Round 1: MR, ch 3 (counts as dc), 11 dc in ring, sl st to top of ch 3. (12 dc)

Round 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in each dc around, sl st to top of ch 3. (24 dc)

Round 3: Ch 3, dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, repeat around, sl st. (36 dc)

Round 4: Ch 3, dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, repeat around, sl st. (48 dc)


Rounds 5–6: Ch 3, dc in each st around, sl st.

Round 7: Ch 3, dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st, repeat around, sl st. (Lace round)

Rounds 8–9: Repeat Round 7.

Round 10: Ch 3, dc in each st and ch-1 space around, sl st. Fasten off. This creates the lace pattern.

FRONT TWIST



TURBAN MEASUREMENTS (approx.)


Size	Head Circumference	Diameter (Flat)
Adult	21–23 in (53–58 cm)	9–10 in (23–25 cm)
Teen	20–21 in (51–53 cm)	8–9 in (20–23 cm)

MATERIALS

- Medium (4) weight yarn
- Crochet hook US I/9 (5.5 mm)
- Yarn needle, scissors

CROCHET LEAF TIE PATTERN & STITCH GUIDE (US TERMS)

LEAF MOTIF DIAGRAM




LEAF INSTRUCTIONS (MAKE 12–14 LEAVES)

Foundation: Ch 7.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next 4 ch, 3 sc in last ch. (You will work along the other side of the chain.)

Row 2: Hdc in next 4 ch, 2 sc in last ch, sl st in next ch. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

LEAF STRAND (Make 5–7 strands)




STITCH GUIDE (US TERMS)

- = chain (ch)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- + = single crochet (sc)
- ⊥ = half double crochet (hdc)
- ⊥ = double crochet (dc)
- ∩ = picot (ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch)

ASSEMBLY

Gather all leaf strands. Tie them together at the base with yarn to form a tassel. Attach the tassel to the back of the turban. Tie a bow with yarn to secure.



TIPS

- Use a blocking method to shape leaves.
- Adjust strand length and number of leaves as you like.

Gauge

13 dc × 7 rows = 4 inches (10 cm)

Worked in **Double Crochet (dc)**.

US Crochet Abbreviations

- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- dc2tog = double crochet 2 together
- sp = space
- st = stitch
- sts = stitches
- rep = repeat
- MC = Main Color
- FO = Fasten Off

Special Stitch

dc2tog (Double Crochet Two Together)

Yarn over.

Insert hook into the next stitch.

Yarn over and pull up a loop.

Yarn over and pull through 2 loops.

Leave two loops on the hook.

Yarn over.

Insert hook into the next stitch.

Yarn over and pull up a loop.

Yarn over and pull through 2 loops.

Yarn over and pull through all remaining loops.

This decreases one stitch.

Step 1 – Crochet the Crown Circle

The project begins with a flat circular crown.

Round 1

Chain 4.

Join with a Slip Stitch to form a ring.

Chain 3 (counts as first Double Crochet).

Work 11 Double Crochets into the center of the ring.

Join with a Slip Stitch to the top of the beginning Chain 3.

You now have:

12 dc

Round 2

Chain 3.

Work 2 Double Crochets into every stitch around.

Join with Slip Stitch.

Total:

24 dc

The circle should remain perfectly flat.

Round 3

Chain 3.

Work:

- 1 dc in next stitch
- 2 dc in next stitch

Repeat around.

Join with Slip Stitch.

Total:

36 dc

Round 4

Chain 3.

Work:

- 1 dc in next 2 stitches
- 2 dc in next stitch

Repeat around.

Join.

Total:

48 dc

Your circle should now measure approximately 5½ inches.

Step 2 – Begin the Lace Pattern 🌸

The lace creates the lightweight and breathable texture of the turban.

Round 5

Chain 3.

Skip one stitch.

Work into the next stitch:

- dc
- ch 1
- dc

Skip next stitch.

Repeat around.

Join with Slip Stitch.

You are creating evenly spaced lace openings.

Round 6

Slip Stitch into the first Chain-1 Space.

Chain 3.

Into every Chain-1 Space work:

- dc
- ch 1
- dc

Continue around.

Join.

Notice the lace openings lining up vertically.

Round 7

Repeat Round 6.

Continue increasing only enough to keep the fabric laying perfectly flat.

Do not allow the work to cup or ruffle.

Continue Lace Rounds

Repeat the lace pattern until the circle measures:

9–10 inches (23–25 cm)

The exact measurement depends on the wearer's head circumference.

When finished:

Fasten Off.

Leave a long tail for sewing.

Your finished circle should resemble the sample shown in the tutorial chart, with evenly spaced vertical lace openings extending from the center outward.

Step 3 – Form the Front Twist

This step transforms the circular lace piece into the elegant twisted turban shape.

Step 1

Lay the circle flat.

Locate the exact center front.

Fold the circle in half.

The fold should create a clean semicircle.

Step 2

Bring the left front edge inward toward the center.

Hold it in place.

Step 3

Bring the right front edge over the left side.

Cross the two folded sections.

The folds should overlap naturally.

Step 4

Adjust the folds until they resemble a twisted knot.

The twist should sit directly in the center.

Take your time.

Symmetry makes a huge difference in the final appearance.

Step 5

Turn the piece over carefully.

Using the long yarn tail and yarn needle,

Sew the back securely.

Use small invisible whip stitches.

Do not stitch through the decorative front twist.

Only secure the back folds.

Step 6

Turn the turban right side out.

Shape gently with your hands.

The front twist is now complete.

The body of the turban should comfortably stretch over the head while keeping the twist centered.

Step 4 – Crochet the Leaf Tie 🌿

The decorative tie consists of individual leaves attached to long crochet chains.

Part A – Crochet One Leaf

Beginning

Chain 7.

Starting in the second chain from hook:

Work:

- sc
- hdc
- dc
- dc
- hdc
- sc

At the tip:

Chain 3.

Rotate to work along the opposite side.

Work:

- sc
- hdc
- dc
- dc
- hdc
- sc

Slip Stitch into the first stitch.

Fasten Off.

Leave a long sewing tail.

The finished leaf should measure approximately:

2½–3 inches long.

Shape the Leaf

Fold the leaf gently.

Using the yarn tail,

Sew the bottom slightly closed.

This gives the leaf a natural three-dimensional shape.

Make More Leaves

Repeat until you have:

12–14 leaves

Try to keep every leaf identical in size.

Part B – Make the Leaf Strands

Strand Base

Chain 30.

Or make a longer chain if you prefer a longer tie.

Attach Leaves

Fold one leaf in half.

Slip Stitch it around the chain.

Continue by adding another leaf after:

5 chains.

Repeat across the chain.

Each strand usually holds:

3–4 leaves.

Make Multiple Strands

Create:

3–4 separate leaf strands.

Each strand should have similar spacing.

Part C – Assemble the Tie

Place all strands together.

Using yarn,

Tie them tightly at one end.

Wrap yarn several times around the base.

Secure with several knots.

Weave in all ends.

You now have a beautiful leaf tassel.

Attach the Tie to the Turban

Locate the back center seam.

Thread the tie through one of the lace openings.

Position it evenly.

Tie into a loose bow or knot.

The leaf strands should drape naturally down the back.

They may also be worn over one shoulder for a decorative look.

Finishing

Weave in every loose yarn end.

Trim excess yarn.

Lightly block the finished turban.

Shape the twist while blocking.

Allow it to dry completely before wearing.

Tips for the Best Results

Choose a soft cotton or cotton-blend yarn for maximum comfort.

Maintain even stitch tension throughout the project.

Count stitches at the end of every increase round.

Avoid over-tightening the front twist during sewing.

Steam block lightly if needed.

Do not overstretch the lace openings.

Customize the tie length by adding or removing chain stitches.

Additional leaves can be added for a fuller decorative tassel.

Quick Reference

Crown

- Magic Ring or Chain Ring
- Increase to 48 dc
- Begin lace pattern

Body

- Repeat lace rounds
- Continue until 9–10 inches in diameter

Front Twist

- Fold
- Cross front edges
- Sew back securely
- Turn right side out

Leaf Tie

- Make 12–14 leaves
- Create 3–4 leaf strands
- Join strands
- Attach to back of turban

Care Instructions

Hand wash in cool water using a mild detergent.

Do not wring.

Press gently in a towel to remove excess moisture.

Lay flat to dry while reshaping the front twist and leaf strands.

Store flat to help preserve the elegant twisted design.

When finished, you'll have a lightweight, breathable **Crochet Lace Turban with Leaf Tie** featuring an elegant lace body, a beautifully sculpted front twist, and a decorative cascading leaf tassel that matches the tutorial chart while providing enough detail for crocheters of any skill level to complete the project from start to finish.
